Clark Perks discussed the possibility of lakefront tree removal. There are trees, all along the lakefront, which are in danger of falling into the lake. He was going to catalog those trees and designate their homeowners. He would also look into a quote for all of their removal (in bulk).

Jerry Morgan read a letter sent to the Board concerning 24 East Centennial. He will respond to the group directly.

Chuck Nugent discussed the dam litigation. Samost has lost his appeal and hopefully we will be moving forward shortly.
