

BOAT / KAYAK / CANOE REGISTRATION

All members' boats that use the lake or are stored at the beach need to be registered with the Centennial Pines Club.

This helps to recover lost boats, prevent non-members from using the lake, and organize the beach boat racks.

All boats used on the lake should have a registration label(s).

Any boat stored at the beach should have a registration label with a unique registration number.

Unregistered boats will be periodically removed from the beach.

As a precondition for use of our boat on Centennial Pines Club property, we (the above named resident(s)) enter into this agreement with the Club, subject to the following terms and conditions

1. Our boat(s) is (are) identified and described fully above
2. If stored at the beach, when not in active use, our boat shall be secured by a lock in the assigned space on the boat racks provided by the Club, and no other place. Available space on the racks shall be assigned by the CPC Board. I will provide a chain and lock to be used to secure the boat to the rack. I will immediately correct any problems relating to our boat storage upon being notified by the Club or persons using it.
3. We recognize that the racks are provided merely as an accommodation to the residents. The Club shall have no duty to provide supervision, lighting, or security for our boat or persons using it.
4. Our boat will only be used by competent swimmers who are properly trained to operate the boat. The Board of Health requires that an adult must accompany all people under 16 and each boat must be equipped with the one approved life jacket or floatation device for each occupant. The Board of Health also states that all occupants 10 years of age or younger must wear an approved life jacket at all times while on the water.
5. We acknowledge that boating on the lake can be called a hazardous activity. We assume all risks related to such activity and agree to indemnify defend and hold the Club harmless from claims for damage or injury to persons or property arising out of boating activity on the lake by us, our children, and our guests.
6. On behalf of ourselves, our children, and our guests, we agree that we shall abide by all the rules and regulations of the Centennial Pines Club, the Township of Medford and the State of NJ. If the rules and regulations are not followed, we are aware that we shall lose our boating privileges.
7. After they are issued to me, I agree to prominently display a current registration sticker on the relevant boat.
